Bring the Arts to Ashland-Greenwood

We're on a mission to close the fine arts gap within the rapidly growing Ashland-Greenwood community.

The Ashland-Greenwood Community Performing Arts Center (AGCPAC) will provide a much-needed venue for music, theater and dance performances, and a space to gather in the spirit of arts, humanities and civic engagement. The center will serve Ashland-Greenwood students and the people who live in these communities — while attracting thousands of guests from across Eastern Nebraska and beyond.



Setting the Scene

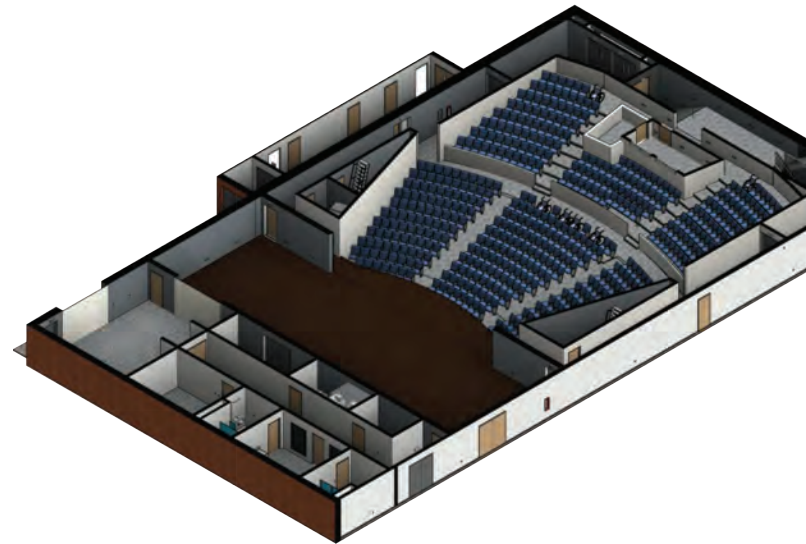
Nestled between Lincoln and Omaha in close proximity to Mahoney State Park, Ashland is a thriving center of commerce, education and recreation.

The only performing arts venue within a 20-mile radius of this growing community is the Ashland-Greenwood High School gymnasium.

So it's no surprise that choir, band and drama groups must often compete for rehearsal time with basketball and volleyball practices. It's not unusual for students to travel up to 30 miles to rehearse — placing undue financial burden and time strain on families, especially those without financial means to make these trips.

Not only is the high school gym insufficient in meeting the needs of the rapidly growing student population, but it also has inadequate acoustics, lighting and seating for performing arts. The gym's lack of contemporary technology limits its practical use as a public venue.

Ashland-Greenwood's venue deficit limits cultural opportunities for the growing school district and the surrounding community.



Campaign Goals

Youth Engagement

AGCPAC will provide a much-needed space apart from the high school gymnasium for students to sing, dance and act. Modern technology will also enhance opportunities for students to master sound engineering, light choreography, set design and more.

Economic Advancement

The performing arts center is the opportunity we've been waiting for to invest in our own potential — delivering great economic impact to the entire local region. AGCPAC will serve as a beacon of fine arts, attracting visitors and generating revenue through ticket sales.

Community Connection

At its core, AGCPAC will be a space to gather. The auditorium's layout and tech features make it an optimal venue for school and civic meetings.
